Topic	Birds
Vocabulary	Feathers; wing; beak; nest; eggs
Activities	Draw a picture of a bird and label the feathers, wing and beak. Listen to the nursery rhyme “Two little Dickie birds”. Talk about the rhyme (eg how many birds, what colour feathers?)
